We established a partnership with Tariro, a Christian Vocational - Technical training center about a mile from our current base in Mozambique. Tariro means hope, and we believe this partnership will bring hope to Mozambique! It's a two year discipleship program that also teaches employable skills such as metal work/ welding, carpentry, auto mechanics and agriculture.

A Note From Tracy

We received community and government approval to build a preschool in a new village. Classes start any day now. We also built a new kitchen at our vocational school, plus a new playground for the kiddos!

Plus:

- We held a graduation ceremony for our preschool classes advancing to primary school!
- We launched our new Prayer Outreach. This is a network of faithful ones who have committed to pray with us!
- We sent one of our missionaries to a public health training with Seeds of Hope International and a Discipleship Intensive School with Antioch.
- We've scoped out three fairly large unreached people-groups: the Yao, the Makua, and most recently, the Tonga. Collectively they number over six million people and span three neighboring nations. Now we pray to the Lord of the Harvest, send forth laborers! Come join us!
- Our clinic continues to touch the lives of hundreds of families far and wide in our region.
- Our staff recovered from... how many bouts of malaria? Can't remember, but ALL of them! 🤔

In addition to all of this happening at our main base, Tariro is growing. Tariro is the Vocational/Discipleship Training Center we partnered with in 2016. We graduated more than 40 young adults in December. All of the students were placed in jobs and we're so proud of them! We also built a new kitchen for the students!

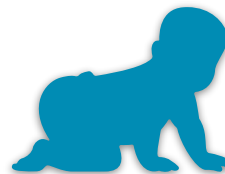

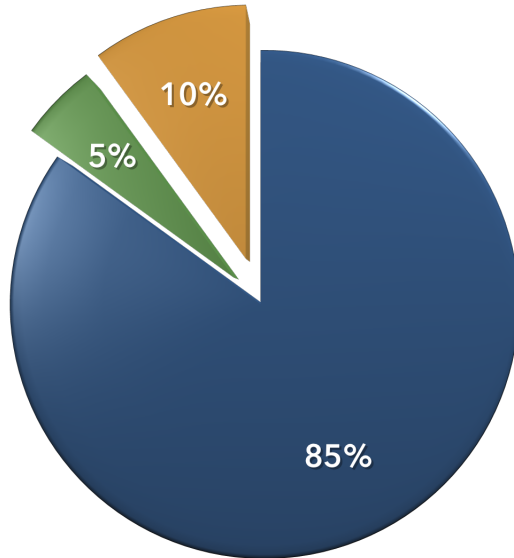
